# OUR BLAZER

Our jacket is inspired by our identity as the last class of the 20th century, with a design that emphasizes a pre-digital aesthetic. Our classmates asked for a jacket made of natural materials that would feel comfortable and relaxed at reunions, fitting in well with our theme, Bid Every Care Withdraw. Our custom seersucker fabric in a soft Princeton orange is lined with the lyrics to Old Nassau in a newsprint style - remember when we got a Prince at our doorstep every morning - and a graphic tiger head. The jacket was designed by a committee led by classmate Katie Oman, who also designed our Beer Jacket 25 years ago.

Under the collar we have hidden the word Hurrah! as a reminder that, though we have been through difficult moments as a class and individually, this 25th reunion milestone is a chance to celebrate our accomplishments, our friendships, and our dear Old Nassau.

Our reunion has two logos, the tiger head in profile, representing our strong spirit, and our relaxed tiger, influenced by the Proctor tigers who flank Nassau Hall. This is the tiger who has, we believe, Bid Every Care Withdraw. The jacket designers, together with the rest of the Reunions committee, want to emphasize togetherness, presence, joy, and the support we can find in one another through this reunions theme. We have many different viewpoints but we come together here because of our gratitude for our Princeton experience.



# Blazer Tips & Tricks

- Your Blazer is flat packed, ready to wear and not on a hanger. It does include a loop at the neckline so you can hang it on a hook.
- Don't forget to snip the pockets and back vent.
- The breast pocket has a pop-out built-in pocket square.
- The sleeves can be unbuttoned and rolled.
- It has a tear tag with your size/care instructions and a place to carefully write your name (please do this, there will be 700 matching blazers around reunions weekend).
- There is a sewn-in tag that you can embroider or ink your name in a more lasting fashion after reunions.
- Please wear your blazer to the Class Dinner and P-Rade!

Our blazer is very comfortable, and it is a shade of orange which we hope will be flattering for all! The jacket looks terrific with grey, black, off white, khaki and jeans. As a committee we made a conscious goal to not have too many “official” formal elements in our costume package. We want you to be able to grab your favorite items you already own to Bid Every Care Withdraw! We will be honest, our shade of slightly less saturated Princeton Orange (#F08C42) may not look the best with competing shades of orange.
